Also, All exterior doors and paint colors must conform to traditional colonial styling and colors.

Please also remember these covenants are put in place to keep our neighborhood consistent in appearance and one in which you will take pride in being a part of.

The ACC has granted the following exceptions for approved roofing & siding replacements for the Gates Head Community. They are listed as follows:

All siding for homes erected in Gates Head neighborhood will be:

- 1. Beaded wood or Masonite
- 2. Beaded Vinyl siding (smooth siding is not permitted)
- 3. Beaded Hardy Plank

All roofing materials will be:

- 1. Cedar Shake
- 2. Slate
- 3. Composite *Grand Manor Shangle* by Certainteed (Approved colors only)
